- 1a) All fixtures to be played on or before the set date in accordance to the WRU Pathway rules. No matches to take place after the set date. Failure to fulfil a fixture in accordance to the set dates will result in both teams being eliminated from the competition.

2. Home team to provide neutral referees for the fixture; the home side is responsible for paying the referees expenses. A neutral referee is deemed to be a licensed referee that has no affiliation with the respective age grade or club (not a coach of that particular team / parent)

3. All players must be registered and all ID cards must be brought to the fixture for inspection by coaches/managers.

4. Any complaints or disputes must be made in writing to the WRU offices within 72 hrs of the fixture taking place.

5. Players may play one year up, and the age group limit is from September 1st of that year.

6. If the home side pitch is unplayable and the away side is playable then the fixture will be reversed.

7. In the event of a draw the away side goes through-there will be no extra time.
8. If a player has to leave the field injured and the opposition has no replacement available the opposition will remain at 15 players.
9. If a side has no front row replacement and the game has to be played with uncontested scrums the team that requests uncontested scrums will not forfeit the game.
10. Home Team must confirm the result of the matches ASAP, as an open draw will take place after every round.
11. There will be a plate competition for all teams eliminated in the 1st Round. (Not Preliminary)
12. All the above rules apply on Finals Day.
13. In the event of a draw the Trophy will be shared.
